Fuel Zone Menu

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Every day we offer three menus
- We can cater to specific dietary requirements including Halal and vegetarian
- Meals operate on a three-weekly cycle
- All P1s to P3s receive a free lunch from the Fuel Zone
- For P4s to P7s a three course meal with a drink costs £1.90 unless your child is entitled to a free meal.



THE IMPORTANT STUFF

In order to make sure we supply nutritionally balanced meals, our menu is developed in line with current legislation.

The Schools (Health Promotion and Nutrition) (Scotland) Act 2007 aims to improve the diet of Glasgow's young people by developing a wider understanding of food, nutrition and healthy lifestyles in the classroom and at meal times.

Big Breakfast



Breakfast is the most important meal of the day, especially for young minds preparing to learn. Glasgow's Big Breakfast operates in each of the city's primary schools and offers every pupil a nutritional and healthy breakfast at the start of the school day. There is a £2 charge for breakfast for the first child and £1 for additional children (e.g. a parent with two children attending breakfast club would pay £3). Parents are able to pre-purchase breakfast. There is no charge to children entitled to free school meals.

The breakfast service starts at 8am and is supervised in a safe and friendly environment.

- 6000 breakfasts served daily
- 1.3 million breakfasts served each year
- Cereals, fruit juice, toast and low fat spread are available
- Fresh fruit is available

All breakfast services start at 8am

Stay hydrated

The Refresh initiative supplies almost 600 coolers to all Glasgow schools, allowing access to fresh mains-fed water that is filtered, chilled and ready to drink. Better hydration means better performance in school, and water offers an excellent alternative to unhealthy sugary drinks.

- Helps pupils stay healthy
- Improves co-ordination
- Reduces tiredness

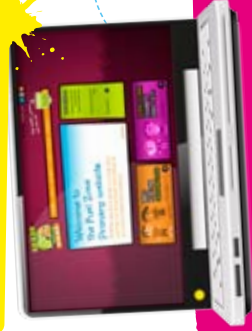

Cashless system

We use a simple cashless card payment system in selected Fuel Zones for all services throughout the day.

Your child can credit their card by using the on-site top up machine, or you can write a cheque to the school's catering manager.

This system reduces the risk of your child losing lunch money and also creates an easier service all round.

Free meal entitlement will be automatically loaded on to your child's card, and you can set the value for a daily spend as well as restrict certain foods your child can buy from the Fuel Zone.

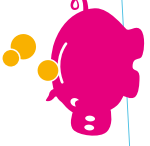
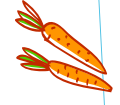
